Signicance:

Karthigai Somavaram refers to the Mondays in the sacred Tamil month of Karthigai (mid-November to mid-December) and is a highly auspicious time to worship Lord Shiva.

Performing special prayers and rituals on these Mondays to Lord Shiva helps gaining divine blessings, and achieving spiritual enlightenment.

Pirathosha Viratham on Tuesday 02 & Wednesday 17-12-2025



Prathosha Viratham is one of the most important viratha among the Virathas performed to Lord Shiva. Pirathosha Viratham comes twice a month (Lunar). Shukla Paksha and Krishna Paksha, the evening of the Thirayodasi (13th moon day) between 4:30-6:00pm. Devotees worship Lord Shiva at this significant time.

If the Pirathosham happened on Saturdays called Sani Pirathosham."

Pradosham is when Lord Siva drank the poison and saved all beings of the world from destruction. It is believed that when Siva descends into the earth plane into the consciousness of people and gives them spiritual awareness. Thus, pradosham liberates a person from an unconscious mind to a conscious and aware mind.

At Sri Serlvavinayakar Temple special Pooja, Lingotbava Stotram & Thiravya Abishekam are performed at Lord Shiva (Amirthagadeswarar)'s Sannithy at 5.00pm

Powrnami-Sarvaalaya Theepam on Thursday 04-12-2025



This Festival is dedicated to the worship of Lord Muruga also known as Kartikeya, is the son of Lord Shiva and Parvati. It is believed that he was born out of Lord Shiva's third eye. Lord Muruga was born on the birth star of Karthigai Nakshatra. Murugan devotees observe fasting on this day and pray to Lord Murugan to get his blessings for happiness in the family, progeny, prosperity and to overcome the obstacles in life. Karthigai theepam is essentially a festival of lamps which is considered as an auspicious symbol in all Hindu rituals and festivals but indispensable for Karthigai. In Hindu religion, it is believed to ward off evil forces and usher in prosperity and joy. The pooja is performed by lighting a ghee lamp made from flour and jaggery.

Lord Satyanarayan is a manifestation of Shri Vishnu, who is also known as Narayan, the one who symbolises eternal truth. The word "Satya" means Truth and "Narayana" means The Highest Being. Together they mean "The highest being who is the embodiment of truth". Hindus perform **Sri Satyanarayan Vrat & Pooja** for getting blessings of health, wealth, prosperity and relief from troubles and sickness. It can also be performed to get success in business or career and during social functions like marriages.

Aanjaneya (Hanuman) Jayanthi is celebrated on the new moon day during the Tamil Month Maarkali.

Special Aarthi to Lord Anjaneyar will be performed with the morning pooja at our temple.

Sri Ayyapa Swamy Abishekam on Saturday 20-12-2025



Special Puja/Abishekam will be performed to Sri Ayyappa Swamy on the first five days of every Hindu calendar month. These poojas are usually named after each Zodiac (Rasi) sign. This month puja called "Kumbha" Masa Abishekam".

Ayyapa Swamy is the epitome of dharma, truth, and righteousness and is often called upon to obliterate evil. He fulfills all good, honest wishes and desires of the devotees and grants good health to the worshipper and their loved ones.

Swamy Ayyappa also bestows prosperity and success upon the devotees and controls the malefic effects of Shani (Saturn).

Tiruvempavai songs are part of an ancient tradition amongst unmarried young girls light lamps in the early mornings of Margazhi and sing songs in praise of Lord Siva. The Tiruvempavai is a collection of songs composed by the poet-saint Manikkavasakar. It consists of 20 stanzas devoted to the Hindu deity Shiva. It forms part of the collection called the Tiruvasagam, and the 8th book of the Tirumurai, a canonical text of the Tamil Shaiva Siddhanta.


Suvarka Vayil-Vaikuntha Ekathasi on Wednesday 31-12-2025



Vaikunta Ekadashi is one of the most important days for Vaishnavites. Ekadashi is an auspicious day dedicated to Lord Vishnu and falls on the eleventh day of every lunar fortnight in traditional Hindu calendar.

The most important ritual on the day in temples is the opening of the Vaikunta Vasal door in Vishnu Temples. This door is only opened on the Vaikunta Ekadasi day and devotees are allowed to pass through it. Symbolically the door leads to the Vaikunta - abode of Vishnu.
