Pirathosha Viratham on Sunday-12 & Monday 27-07-2026



Prathosha Viratham is one of the most important viratha among the Virathas performed to Lord Shiva. Pirathosha Viratham comes twice a month (Lunar). Shukla Paksha and Krishna Paksha, the evening of the Thirayodasi (13th moon day) between 4:30-6:00pm. Devotees worship Lord Shiva at this significant time.

If the Pirathosham happened on Saturdays called Sani Pirathosham.”

Pradosham is when Lord Siva drank the poison and saved all beings of the world from destruction. It is believed that when Siva descends into the earth plane into the consciousness of people and gives them spiritual awareness. Thus, pradosham liberates a person from an unconscious mind to a conscious and aware mind.

Special Puja/Abishekam will be performed to Sri Ayyappa Swamy on the first five days of every Hindu calendar month. These poojas are usually named after each Zodiac (Rasi) sign.

Ayyappa Swamy is the epitome of dharma, truth, and righteousness and is often called upon to obliterate evil. He fulfills all good, honest wishes and desires of the devotees and grants good health to the worshipper and their loved ones.

Swamy Ayyappa also bestows prosperity and success upon the devotees and controls the malefic effects of Shani (Saturn).

Lalitha Sahasra Nama Stotram Chanting on Sunday 19-07-2026



Lalitha Sahasranamam (1000 names of Goddess Lalithambikai Devi) is a secret and very sacred text or mantra in Hindu religion. This mantra has been revealed to mankind through the discussion between lord Hayagriva and the great sage Agasthya.

Aadi Chevaai Viratham on Tuesday 21 & 28-07-2026



Significance of Aadi Chevaai Viratham:

Tamil Calendar month Aadi Masam (Jyeshtha) comes between mid-June to mid-July of the English calendar.

Aadi Chevvai, or Sevvai, refers to Tuesdays and is considered highly auspicious for worshipping Goddess Shakhi. It's a time when women, particularly unmarried women, visit temples dedicated to Goddesses like Amman, Durga, and Parvati, and observe fasts or special prayers. This is believed to help them find ideal husbands or life partners and bring prosperity. While married women pray to the goddess for marital bliss and longer lives for their husbands. Some women also observe partial or full fasts on this day as a form of devotion.

Saint Sundarar Guru Pooja on Friday 22-07-2026



(Sampanthar, Appar, Natarajar, Sivakhami, Sundarar, Manickavasagar at SSVK)

Saiva Saint Sundara Moorthy Nayanar was an eighth-century Poet-Saint and was one of the most prominent Nayanmars. He was born in Thirunavalur village located in Thirumunaippadi Nadu (Tamil Nadu) to Sadaya Nayanar and Isaighaniyar. His childhood name was Nambiyarurar. It is significant to note that both of his parents found a place among the 63 Nayanmars. Sundarar also known affectionately as "Thampiran Thozhan" (Comrade of Lord Shiva) and "Vanthondan" (the argumentative follower). He was a contemporary of Chola King Cherman Perumal, and Kotpuli Nayanar, both also figure in the 63 Nayanmars. The hymns of seventh volume of the Saiva Thirumuraikal compendium of Tamil Saiva Sithantham was composed by him.

Saiva Thirumuraikal is a division of holy hymns for Hinduism composed of total of 12 Thirumuraikal-compendium.

At Sri Selvavinayakar Temple Special Pooja will be performed to Saiva Saint Sundarar with the Morning regular puja at 9:00am.

Full Moon /Povernami/ Sathyanarayana Poojai on Wednesday 29/07/2026



*Lord Satyanarayan is a manifestation of Shri Vishnu, who is also known as Narayan, the one who symbolises eternal truth. The word “Satya” means Truth and “Narayana” means The Highest Being. Together they mean “The highest being who is the embodiment of truth”. Hindus perform **Sri Satyanarayan Vrat & Pooja** for getting blessings of health, wealth, prosperity and relief from troubles and sickness. It can also be performed to get success in business or career and during social functions like marriages.*
